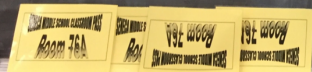

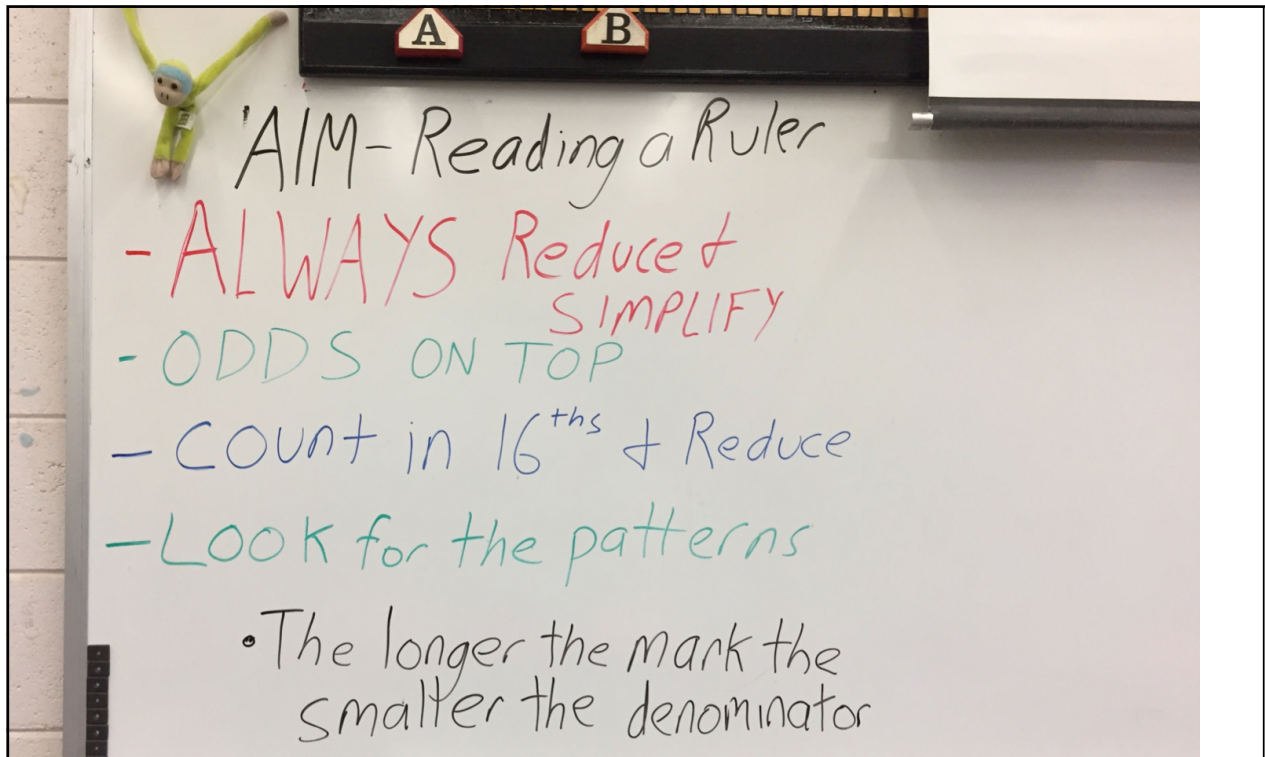

D.N. Have Reference Ruler and Measurement sheets on desk.

AIM- Using a ruler.

When using a ruler place the zero end on the left at the beginning of the line or side you are measuring.

Then locate the end of the surface being measured and look at the ruler reading. Close your eyes, then open them, and read the measurement again. You should have a measurement value that is close to the first number.

If you do not have a number that is close then check that your ruler placement has not shifted, and that you have located the end of the object correctly.
